

North East (41 responses, 15.4%)


North West (24 responses, 9.0%)


Is developing Tourism important to the future of the Town?


Does the Town of Slave Lake need more RV parking?

Should a new RV parking facility be owned and operated by the Town or by a Private Company?


No Opinion (78 responses, 29.2%)

5. I strongly agree with having an RV park in that location.



Instead of an RV Park, Do you believe that council should zone this area for housing?


No (92 responses, 34.5%)

If Yes, What type of housing do you believe should be developed on this land?




QUESTION EIGHT
