

Snow Fort Safety Tips:

- Make a few ventilation holes through the top of the snow fort by using a long stick. Make sure the holes stay clear of snow and debris!
- Don't stand on top of your snow fort, especially with someone inside.
- Don't light up a gas stove, lantern, or any other chemicals. This can give you a lethal dose of carbon monoxide even with ventilation holes.
