

**TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE
BYLAW NO. 17-2018**

**A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE A SPECIAL TAX TO RAISE REVENUE FOR COSTS
ASSOCIATED WITH THE PAVING OF 5TH AVENUE NW**

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 382 of the *Municipal Government Act*, a council may pass a special tax bylaw to raise revenue to pay for a specific service or purpose by imposing one or more special taxes, including a paving tax;

AND WHEREAS, the Council for the Town of Slave Lake has adopted the 2018 Budget approving the 5th Avenue NW Road Rehabilitation Project, which includes an estimated expenditure of \$500,997 for paving the road;

AND WHEREAS, all properties in the municipality will benefit from the paving of 5th Avenue NW;


AND WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the public interest to impose a paving tax in respect of all properties in the municipality that are not otherwise exempt from taxation by statute;

AND WHEREAS, it is deemed to be just and equitable to set a special tax rate that will collect an equal amount of special tax from each parcel of land within the municipality sufficient to raise \$500,997.

NOW THEREFORE the council of the Town of Slave Lake, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited as the "2018 5th Avenue NW Paving Tax Bylaw".
2. A special tax for the year 2018 in the amount of \$215.48 per parcel of land shall be imposed on each parcel of land in the municipality that is not exempt from taxation under section 351 of the *Municipal Government Act*.
3. The special tax imposed by this bylaw is for the specific purpose of raising revenue to fund the costs of paving 5th Avenue NW, which costs are estimated to total \$500,997.


