

BY-LAW # 21-2001

TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND THE SOUTHWEST AREA STRUCTURE PLAN, BEING BY-LAW #20-1988.

Pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1994, as amended, the Municipal Council of the Town of Slave Lake, duly assembled, enacts as follows:


1. That Map 4, Land Use Concept, of the Southwest Area Structure Plan, being Bylaw #20-1988, be amended as follows:

The area highlighted and shown on the attached sketch marked as Schedule "A" and forming part of this Bylaw, be re-designated from:

Residential to Commercial.


2. That this Bylaw comes into effect upon the date of its Third and final Reading.





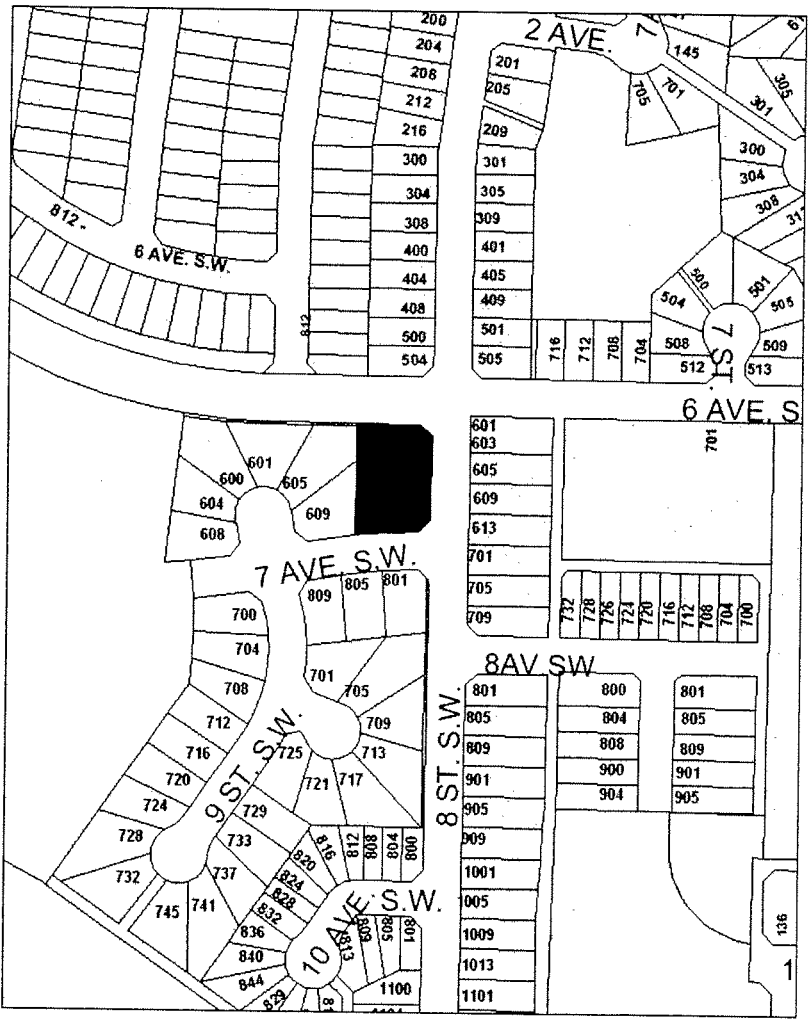
