

ACCEPTABLE WASTES:

Materials Accepted For Class II Landfill:

- Residential Bagged Garbage
- Institutional/Commercial/Industrial Garbage
- Dead Animals, hides, guts, etc
- Asbestos Waste (must be called 24 hours in advance)
- Burner Ash (must be cold)

Materials Accepted For Recycle:

- Glass, cardboard, plastic film, hard plastic, paper, tin cans
- Metal: cable, wire, BBQ's, mowers, scrap metal, bikes, etc.
- Cans, bottles, milk jugs, etc. for deposit (all proceeds go to charity)
- Tires & tracks
- Propane tanks
- Electronics: TV's, computers, keyboards, small kitchen appliances, stereos, power tools, basically anything with electronic components.
- Fluorescent light tubes (contain mercury and cadmium, please do not throw into waste bin!)
- Used oil & jugs
- Car batteries, rechargeable batteries, and disposable batteries
- Waste paint, aerosols, household hazardous wastes (such as windex, bleach, fantastic, all-purpose cleaners, etc.)
- Potentially useful/reusable items for Take It or Leave It (NO appliances, electronics, liquids, or broken items. If it's not something you'd take, don't leave it.)

Materials Accepted For Burn Pile:

- Clean wood items that have not been painted or treated
- Trees, branches, stumps, logs, etc
- No plywood, OSB, particle board, or furniture

Materials Accepted for Compost:

- Yard Materials-grass, leaves, brush less than 3cm in diameter, garden waste, straw, etc.
- Manure-not in large quantities
- Remove any and all plastics, bags, pieces of wood, or waste from compost

Materials Accepted For Class III Landfill:

- Construction/renovation/demolition debris – includes drywall, painted wood or wood debris, insulation, shingles, flooring, siding, matting, etc.
- Asphalt
- Ceramics & glass
- Furniture – mattresses, dressers, desks, tables, couches, chairs, etc.
- Plastic such as toys, containers, strollers, plastic tubing, etc.

- **NO** bagged waste, fluorescent tubes or fixtures, paints or aerosols, oil jugs or pails, or liquids.

Materials Residents Are Charged For:

- Refrigerators - \$25.00 per unit, unless they have a 'Freon-removed' certificate.
- White Goods - \$10.00 per unit. This includes stoves, dishwashers, dryers, washers, etc.
- Vehicle Bodies - \$25.00 per unit. All fluids must be removed.

Appliance Free Day – Domestic appliance and vehicle bodies will be accepted free of charge on the first open Saturday of every month. Only one of each type of appliance will be accepted (i.e. one fridge, one stove, etc.) and this does not include appliances from commercial entities.

Residents will get the first 500 kg of their loads paid for by the Town or MD, but will be subject to the above charges if they go over the 500 kg limit. Residents will be subject to a mixed load charge of \$150.00/load for loads that have mixed materials, such as metal and concrete, or metal and ash, subject to landfill staff discretion. We currently accept cash, cheques, and debit.
