

**BYLAW #07-2020
AMENDMENT TO THE LAND USE BYLAW
TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE**

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND LAND USE BY-LAW #22-2007.

Pursuant to the Municipal Government Act being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, as amended, the Municipal Council of the Town of Slave Lake, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That Section 3 be amended by adding the following:

“Food Production” means a use:

- a) where plants are grown to produce food in a building;
- b) that may include hydroponics, aquaponics, and vertical growing;
- c) where food grown on-site may be processed and packaged;
- d) that may include aquaculture and raising insects for food;
- e) where no dust or vibration is seen or felt outside of the building; and
- f) where all of the processes and functions associated with the use are contained in a fully enclosed building.

“Agricultural Operation” and “Cannabis Production Facilities” are separate uses.

2. That Section 87(3) shall be amended by adding the following:

Food Production


That this Bylaw comes into effect upon the date of its Third and Final Reading.


